
The Kinder Park project was awarded the first prize in the design competition for the urbanarchitectural concepts for strategic urban projects, part of the neighborhood plan for the "Valle de Puebla" housing complex in Mexicali, Baja California.



The proposal consolidates the footprints left by the surrounding citizen activity, revealing the natural program of the surrounding inhabitants. It is then materialized it in a dynamic interwoven strategy (such as the traces on the ground that outline the rings for the children's games) that embraces spaces of different scales and conditions, drawing closed geometries that are built like sidewalks. The circles are outfitted with play structures and furniture to activate the neighborhood program,
