



NEWSBURGH ENCLOSURES: SWF AS A CATALYST FOR DEVELOPMENT

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Situated 60 miles north of Manhattan, the once-grand and historic city of Newburgh has suffered the effects of economic stagnation, intergenerational poverty and post-industrial decline. However, Newburgh is beginning to rise once again. One of the most promising drivers for Newburgh's economic development is its airport.
